

Terms of Use

1. Prohibitions

1.1 Legal Violations

All data, content, and activities, as well as the promotion of or participation in such, that violate Swiss or international law are prohibited. This includes, among other things, the storage or distribution of data protected by copyright or trademark rights without authorisation. In cases of conflicting laws, Onlime reserves the right to determine the applicable law.

1.2 Discriminatory Content

The storage or distribution of racist, discriminatory, or violence-glorifying content is not permitted. In ambiguous cases, the assessment is at Onlime's discretion.

1.3 Abuse

Activities, as well as the promotion of or participation in such, that are considered abusive are prohibited. This includes, among other things:

- mass distribution of unsolicited messages (spam, bulk mailing, etc.)
- attacks against other systems (DDoS attacks, unauthorised intrusion into third-party systems, etc.)

- exploitation of security vulnerabilities
- phishing and other forms of internet fraud

The assessment of whether conduct is considered abusive is at Onlime's discretion.

2. Violations

2.1 Definition

Any non-compliance with a prohibition listed under section 1 constitutes a violation, regardless of whether it was intentional, unknowing, or caused by a third party.

2.2 Detection

A violation may be detected through the review of reports or complaints from third parties, or through internal audits.

2.3 Consequences

The decisive factor is the severity of the violation as assessed by Onlime. Any measures taken shall be proportionate. In any case, the customer will receive at minimum a warning. In the event of a serious or repeated violation, Onlime reserves the right to terminate the contract without notice, or to immediately suspend the affected content, service, account, or server.
